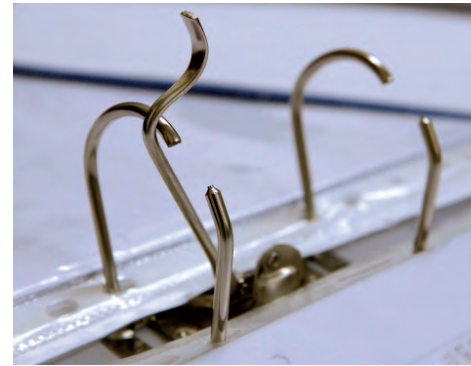

Women's Lives has been widely praised by government, employers and women who have completed the course over the last few years.

What's it all about?

Women's Lives is not about going back to school. It is a course specifically designed for women who have been away from learning for a long time but would now like to take up new learning opportunities. There are no tests or exams, but you will get nationally recognised credits equivalent to NVQs and GCSEs.

What's in the course?

Women's Lives will help you to develop your skills and give you confidence in Writing, Investigating/Research, Analysing and Problem Solving. The course looks at issues of interest to women and draws on your experiences at work and home.

Who is it for?

Women's Lives is for women of all ages and past students have come from a variety of backgrounds such as care assistants, community health workers, catering staff, cleaning and laundry staff, nurses and clerical workers. They have found that it helps them both in their jobs and outside work.

What will it involve?

You will join a regular study group which meets once a week in the evening at a local venue. You will have a woman tutor who will run the study group, help and advise you and give you feedback. The sessions aim to be informal and friendly. There will also be one residential weekend school.

Women's Lives is FREE!

This is a course for women UNISON members only and all costs and expenses will be paid for by UNISON including workbooks, travel expenses and all the costs associated with the weekend school. There is also help available for childcare and/or dependent care costs.
